



2025 Tuscany Community Clean Up Information

Who: Open to the public and free to attend except for mattress/car seat recycling (additional cost-see below) When: **Sunday, September 14th 9:00am to 2:00pm (times are firm, no early or late access)** Where: Tuscany Club - 212 Tuscany Way NW

We will have volunteers present to help direct traffic and support vendors and participants, but all participants will be responsible for unloading materials and ensuring that items are sorted correctly. Please see specific vendor information below for what is accepted and not accepted at each vendor station. **We will not be accepting any hazardous waste of any kind, paint, tires/car batteries or prohibited items. Please note that most tire stores will accept up to 4 tires off rims, for recycling free of charge.**

Please see the attached map so that you may plan your visit efficiently. The packer trucks are last and participants are asked to maximize use of the vendors to minimize the items that are added to our landfills. **We will not be accepting mattresses and car seats at the packer trucks. They must be recycled for the additional fee or disposed of personally.** Traffic will flow one way through the parking lot with cars lining up to enter the parking lot along Tuscany Way/Tuscany Blvd. Every effort will be made to minimize wait times and facilitate sorting and drop offs. We encourage you to use the attached map to pre-plan your visit.
