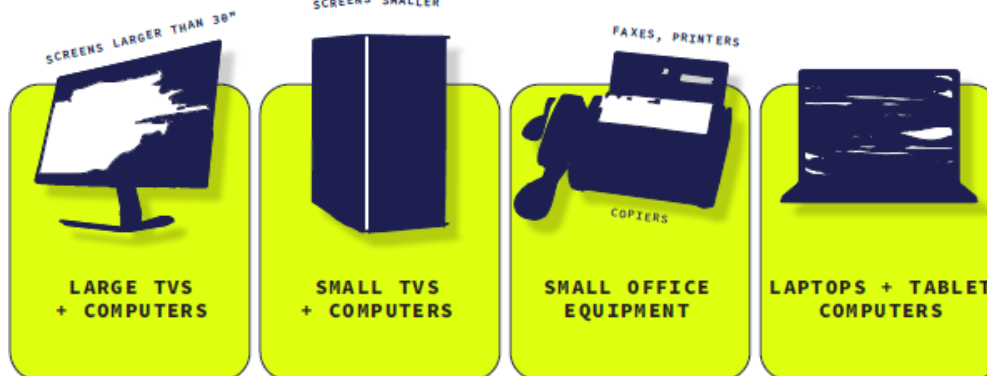

2026 Tuscany Community Clean Up Information

Who: Open to the public and free to attend

When: Saturday, September 12th 9:00am to 2:00pm (times are firm, no early or late access)

Where: Tuscany Club - 212 Tuscany Way NW

We will have volunteers present to help direct traffic and support vendors and participants, but all participants will be responsible for unloading materials and ensuring that items are sorted correctly. Please see specific vendor information below for what is accepted and not accepted at each vendor station. **We will not be accepting any hazardous waste of any kind, paint, tires/car batteries or prohibited items. Please note that most tire stores will accept up to 4 tires off rims, for recycling free of charge.**

Please see the attached map so that you may plan your visit efficiently. The packer trucks are last and participants are asked to maximize use of the vendors to minimize the items that are added to our landfills. **We will not be accepting mattresses and car seats at the packer trucks.** Traffic will flow one way through the parking lot with cars lining up to enter the parking lot along Tuscany Way/Tuscany Blvd. Every effort will be made to minimize wait times and facilitate sorting and drop offs. We encourage you to use the attached map to pre-plan your visit.

As per the City of Calgary, there will be 3 packer trucks available for waste and landfill items but only two trucks will be loaded at one time to keep one available, should the others fill and have to leave prior to the end of the event. All participants will be responsible for following safety precautions and loading items into packer trucks with guidance from staff and volunteers.

General Safety

Getting as many residents through is a focus we support but
Safety is our first priority

- When material is packed into the truck there is potential for items to break and cause flying debris as the material is packed into the truck.
- When the truck is packing materials all residents will be instructed to stay away from the rear of the vehicle to minimize the potential of debris causing injury to people or damage to vehicles.
 - Please make sure volunteers are aware of the safety concern and also stay back. City employees rely on volunteers to assist in keeping the work area safe for everyone
- City employees will not pack the truck if there is potential to injure citizens and volunteers.

Safety – for Volunteers and Residents

For your safety and the safety of residents at community clean ups we require that when the truck is packing that all volunteers, residents and vehicles stay beside the cone to avoid any potential debris.
